

The Minutes for the Park Board Meeting held on Tuesday, April 17, 2018 at Bellefontaine Neighbors Recreation Center.

Mark Dickerson opened the Park Board Meeting at 7:02 p.m.

Mark asked if everyone received the Minutes for the March Park Board Meeting and they were accepted as presented.

Mark reported speaking to Jay with SWT regarding a time line for the project on Bissell Hills Park and received pictures of restrooms and pavilions for the Park Board members to look at. There are many styles of pavilions and I would like you to put a check mark next to the ones you like. Don't worry about the colors at this time, just the styles. Mark made the same comment about the restrooms also. Next month on May 15th SWT will be here to show the layout of the park with the pavilion and restrooms you liked and then we can discuss locations and colors for the building. SWT hopes to have the plans done by June to send them out for bids. Other ideas discussed were steel roofs, pre-fab restrooms, light poles on walkways and cameras to monitor activity after hours.

The City Beautification Day held by the Beautification Board, originally scheduled for March 24th was cancelled and rescheduled for Saturday, April 28th.

Mark reported we are working on the Summer Brochure and it should be dropped off at the Post Office and will go out the week of May 14th.

Mark mentioned Channel 4 picks a good City to live in and this week it was Bellefontaine Neighbors. Some of the reasons given were our City is close to everywhere in the Metro area and we have a great Recreation Center. A discussion followed.
