**APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motion to approve agenda** made by Alderwoman Avant-Elliott seconded by Alderwoman Reed. Mayor asked for ayes and nays. **Motion passed unanimously.**

**BUDGET DISCUSSION**

**Motion made** by Alderwoman Tatman to table the budget discussion seconded by Alderwoman Dailes.

**Point of order** called by Alderwoman West to table the ongoing discussion. **Votes** are as follows: Alderwoman West-yes, Alderwoman Tatman-yes, Alderwoman Reed-no, Alderman Carroll-no, Alderman Thomas-absent, Alderman Christian-yes, Alderwoman Dailes-yes, Alderwoman Avant-Elliott-no. **Motion passed with 4-3 vote.**

**BILL NO. 2587, AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2020-2021 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE NEIGHBORS, MISSOURI INTRODUCED BY ALDERWOMAN AVANT-ELLIOTT.**

**Motion made by Alderwoman Avant-Elliott** to table Bill No. 2587 to Regular Board Meeting, July 2, 2020 seconded by Alderwoman West.

**Alderwoman Avant-Elliott** made a motion to rescind her motion to table Bill No. 2587 seconded by Alderwoman West.

**Motion made by Alderwoman Reed** to have in the 2021 budget a salary for City Administrator using \$34,000 from general fund (with \$14,000 already an ordinance to be extracted from Mayor's salary), \$30,000 from capital, \$20,000 from sewer and \$20,000 from street bond and to post the position from July 1 through August 31, 2020 in all the normal media, MML, the paper etc. seconded by Alderwoman West. **Votes are as follows:** Alderwoman West-yes, Alderwoman Tatman-no, Alderwoman Reed-yes, Alderwoman Carroll-yes, Alderwoman Thomas-absent, Alderwoman Christian-yes, Alderwoman Dailes-no, Alderwoman Avant-Elliott-yes. **Motion passed with 5-2 vote.**

**Motion made by Alderwoman Avant-Elliott** to table Bill No. 2587 until Thursday General Board Meeting with all the necessary amendments included seconded by Alderman Carroll. **Votes are as follows:** Alderwoman West-yes, Alderwoman Tatman-no, Alderwoman Reed-yes, Alderwoman Carroll-yes, Alderwoman Thomas-absent, Alderwoman Christian-yes, Alderwoman Dailes-no, Alderwoman Avant-Elliott-yes. **Motion passed with 5-2 vote.**
