

**CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE NEIGHBORS
BOARD OF ALDERMEN MEETING MINUTES
September 19, 2013**

MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY Mayor Robert J. Doerr at 5:45 p.m. Copies of all ordinances and resolutions to be considered at the meeting were made available for public inspection prior to the time of consideration by the Board of Aldermen.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG was led by Mayor Doerr.

ROLL CALL:

PRESENT: Mayor Robert J. Doerr, Chief Pruetz, City Attorney Kevin O'Keefe, City Collector Mark Tranel, City Clerk Deni Donovan, Alderman Paro, Alderman Migliazzo, Alderman Merz, Alderman Schultz, Alderman Roth, Alderman Hollis, and Alderman Smith.

ABSENT: Alderman Jordan

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA: Alderman Roth moved for the approval of the Agenda, seconded by Alderman Hollis. Motion carried unanimously.

MEETING OPEN TO THE PUBLIC: Alderman Roth moved to open the meeting to the public, for as long as the Mayor deems necessary, seconded by Alderman Merz. Motion carried unanimously.

Alderman Smith walked in at this time.

PUBLIC HEARING: For the purpose of an Ordinance establishing the annual rate of Ad Valorem Tax levied for the year 2013 for the general municipal purposes on all real property in the city of Bellefontaine Neighbors, Missouri.

City Attorney, Kevin O'Keefe, explained in depth the process by which the Property Tax is determined. A discussion with the Board of Aldermen continued.

PEG AND GREG WARNUSZ, 10030 CRETE: Commented on the process.

Mayor Doerr asked if anyone else wished to address the Board. Hearing none, Alderman Jordan moved to bring the meeting back to the Board, seconded by Alderman Smith. Motion carried unanimously.

BILL NO. 2343 – INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN ROTH

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL RATE OF AD VALOREM TAX LEVIED FOR THE YEAR 2013 FOR DEBT SERVICE AND GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE NEIGHBORS, MISSOURI.

Alderman Roth read the Bill for the first time and moved for approval of the first reading of Bill No. 2343 and to go on to the second reading. The motion was seconded by Alderman Schultz. Motion carried unanimously. Alderman Roth then read Bill No. 2343 for a second time and thereafter made a motion that the Bill be approved by the Board of

Aldermen for enactment as an Ordinance, seconded by Alderman Schultz. Motion carried unanimously. **Upon the roll being called the votes were cast as follows:** Alderman Roth, yes; Alderman Migliazzo, yes; Alderman Hollis, yes; Alderman Merz, yes; Alderman Schultz, yes; Alderman Smith, yes; and Alderman Paro, yes.

The majority of the members elected to the Board of Aldermen having voted for passage of Bill No. 2343, the bill was passed by the Board and will become Ordinance No. 2262 when and if signed by the Mayor.

Alderman Smith made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Alderman Hollis. Motion carried unanimously.
