

**CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE NEIGHBORS
BOARD OF ALDERMEN MEETING MINUTES
September 26, 2013**

MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY Board of Aldermen President Anthony Smith at 6:30 p.m. Copies of all ordinances and resolutions to be considered at the meeting were made available for public inspection prior to the time of consideration by the Board of Aldermen.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG was led by Mayor Doerr.

ROLL CALL:

PRESENT: City Clerk Deni Donovan, Alderman Paro, Alderman Schultz, Alderman Roth, Alderman Jordan, Alderman Hollis, and Alderman Smith.

ABSENT: Mayor Doerr, City Attorney Kevin O'Keefe, Chief Pruet, City Collector Mark Tranel, Aldermen Merz and Migliazzo,

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA: Alderman Jordan moved for the approval of the Agenda, seconded by Alderman Roth. Motion carried unanimously.

MEETING OPEN TO THE PUBLIC: Alderman Roth moved to open the meeting to the public, for as long as the Aldermanic President Smith deems necessary, seconded by Alderman Hollis. Motion carried unanimously.

Aldermanic President Smith asked if anyone wished to address the Board. Hearing none, Alderman Jordan moved to bring the meeting back to the Board, seconded by Alderman Hollis. Motion carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

BILL NO. 2344 – INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN ROTH

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE ORDINANCE NO. 2262 AND ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL RATE OF AD VALOREM TAX LEVIED FOR THE YEAR 2013 FOR DEBT SERVICE AND GENERAL MUNICIPAL PURPOSES ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF BELLEFONTAINE NEIGHBORS, MISSOURI.

Alderman Roth read the Bill for the first time and moved for approval of the first reading of Bill No. 2344 and to go on to the second reading. The motion was seconded by Alderman Hollis. Motion carried unanimously. Alderman Roth then read Bill No. 2344 for a second time and thereafter made a motion that the Bill be approved by the Board of Aldermen for enactment as an Ordinance, seconded by Alderman Hollis. Motion carried unanimously. **Upon the roll being called the votes were cast as follows:** Alderman Roth, yes; Alderman Hollis, yes; Alderman Schultz, yes; Alderman Jordan yes; Alderman Smith, yes; and Alderman Paro, yes.

The majority of the members elected to the Board of Aldermen having voted for passage of Bill No. 2344, the bill was passed by the Board and will become Ordinance No. 2263 when and if signed by the Mayor.

Alderman Paro made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Alderman Schultz. Motion carried unanimously.
