

Mark Dickerson opened the Park Board Meeting at 7:01 p.m.

Absent: Jane Davis and Alderman Don Merz

Mark Dickerson asked if everyone received a copy of the Park Board Minutes for the meeting held in June and they were accepted as presented.

Mark Dickerson mentioned the previous Fishing Classes and asked Dave Cross how they are going. Dave reported being worried it would be really be hot. We had the regular seven kids and four others that hadn't been there before. Rich Pflueger knew them and talked them into attending. The kids are really enjoying it. We have one named A. J. and all he wanted to do was see how far he could cast and reel it in. I told him he won't catch any fish unless he leaves the line in the water. A discussion followed. The Program is going well and the kids are really enjoying it. A discussion followed. The next class is scheduled for Thursday, August 3rd from 6:30 – 8:30 p.m.

Mark reported having a meeting with Jay concerning the Grant we're working on for improvements to Bissell Hills Park. We're putting it together to see if we can get \$450,000.00 for the improvements. It is due by August 21, 2017 so we don't have a lot of time. We will try to turn it in early so if there is anything they think we should change or maybe forgot they can send it back for any needed changes. So hopefully we'll get the money for the needed changes.

Judy Mantych reported on the plans for the Solar Eclipse Bash scheduled on Monday August 21st. She mentioned putting fliers on the City website and on the electric sign. Amy started taking reservations yesterday. It will go in local Church bulletins either this weekend or next weekend. We had an Ice Cream Social at church and there were residents and nonresidents interested in attending. Judy mentioned working on a display of the sun and moon for the Solar Eclipse Bash with Ted Stocker as well as having to look for an alternate source for the Eclipse safety glasses. Hopefully it will be a clear and cloudless day and not too hot and everyone will have a good time. A discussion followed.

Mark reported we are trying to have the Fall/Winter Brochure delivered on August 12th. The Scout Troop that delivered the Summer Brochure isn't going to do it. The Mayor is working on having another Scout Troop do it and possibly splitting it and having Marquita Carter and the Members only 3B Outreach Group do part of it. Mark mention the Outreach Group participated in the City Clean up Day along with a Scout Troop. A discussion followed concerning the Brochures being on line and still having the printed copies. Mark said maybe 10 years down the line the paper copies will be obsolete but right now the bulk of the people want the paper copy.

A discussion followed concerning the delivery of the new workout equipment the Friday after our last meeting. There were a few things missing but they ordered them and they've already been delivered. Mark stated we should be in pretty good shape with the new equipment. There are a couple small cuts on one of the cushions, nothing bad but we'll probably buy some naugahyde and have it redone the next day. We'll

paint in the fall when we have more time. We got \$1,750.00 for the old equipment and they moved the original equipment and installed the new equipment. We paid \$15,250.00 for the new equipment.

Mark mentioned the Beer and Wine Event and a discussion followed on possible dates. Mark stated October 7th would be good and Judy suggested speaking to the Mayor to make sure he'll be in town to attend.

Mark mentioned the swim team is doing really well. They have the Prelims on Saturday and Finals on Sunday. Mark stated there are 120 kids on the team. A discussion followed.

Mark stated that's all I have. The next Park Board Meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, August 15, 2017. Hopefully by the next meeting the Brochures will be delivered, kids will be going back to school and we'll be ready for the Eclipse. Mark mentioned if October 7th for the Beer & Wine Event doesn't work for the Mayor we'll go with October 14th.

Kathy Endorf asked if the maintenance staff could check the racquetball schedule and be sure to dust and mop the court if someone is scheduled to play. Kathy reported she had a really bad fall because the floor was dusty. A discussion followed.

The Park Board Meeting adjourned at 7:39 p.m.
