

Public Safety Commission Meeting

August 23, 2018, at 6:30 p.m.

The Riverview Fire Department has three new Shift Commanders and three new Captains.

A reported problem with handicapped obstructions has been resolved.

A discussion continued regarding the infrastructure repair after serious but localized storms. As of now, the Police Department, Fire Department and Street Department have an arrangement to clear the streets, but not to permanently solve the problems. A suggestion was made to research an official mutual aid agreement with other municipalities.

A discussion about CERT Training ensued. Chief Ihler said he would be able to get about 15-20 participants. A motion to recommend a class in 2019 was introduced, but not approved.

A hands-free CPR class may be given in the future.

There is one opening in the Police Department.

The committee regarding police body cameras will select vendors for the program.

The police department is reviving the Chaplain Program.
