BACKGROUND:	The City of Bellefontaine Neighbors City Hall Building constructed in 1968 is approximately (20,000) sq. ft. The city is soliciting proposals for the replacement of the buildings' roof and gutter systems.		
Timing:	Proposals will be submitted in Fall of 2024. It is expected that approval will come in Fall of 2024 and an order for the work

PERMITS:	Contractors shall apply for and obtain permits from all Authorities Having Jurisdiction (AHJ)
SCOPE OF WORK:	The Scope of Work for this contract should include furnishing of all labor, materials and equipment necessary to remove and replace the existing roof system, gutters and downspouts at 9641 Bellefontaine Rd. (City Hall). The current roof system (approximately 7,500 sq. ft in total), consists primarily of Flintkote, asphalt felt, gravel, bitumen, shingle and flashings. Insulation will be required around rooftop air conditioners.
	Base Bid Provide a lump sum bid to replace flat roof area and gutters with material similar to existing, including labor, material and warranty information.
	Bid Alternate Provide a bid for an alternate material for the flashing, gutters and downspouts while maintaining the current asthetics of the building. Please provide copies of the specification sheets for the particular products you intend to use.
	 Job Special Provisions A. The Contractor shall carefully review the project to determine all necessary design parameters. B. The Contractor shall submit signed Contracts, Performance Bond, Certificate of Insurance and other required submittals to the Director of Public Works prior to the issuance of a Notice to Proceed with the work.
